


Seaside Rock Trail 3 - Green End Road, St Judith's Field and Middlefield Road, via some narrow ways and some wide ones.

Total walking distance: approximately 2.3km. This is the longest of our treasure trails so may take a little longer than the others, but it is worth it for the view from the top of St Judith's Field.

Start anywhere you like on the trail. All of the answers are clearly visible from the trail and you don't need to enter any private property or cross any roads unless specifically mentioned in the instructions. If there has been rain recently, make sure you wear suitable wet-weather shoes as this walk could be a little muddy.

On your way around, look out for some large Seaside Rock logos like the one below (not counting any that are on a poster for the Holiday Club). There are 2 to find and you will be able to enter their locations in the final question. You will need to enter the numbers of the houses where you see them to get the points, so make a careful note.



From outside John Green's newsagents on Green End Road

Walk away from the Bell public house and turn right into the alley immediately after the bus shelter, then follow the path until it emerges on Scotney Way. Answer the questions below on the way.

Now walk down to the bottom corner of the field. Then, turn left and walk along the side of the dyke until you come to a narrow footbridge.

If the field is too muddy, you could turn right, cut through the gap onto Rockingham Road, then turn left and walk the end of Monks Way to find the next few clues.

What colour are the arrows attached to the opposite end of the bridge?

Cross the bridge and turn right, then right again through the gap in the trees just after the concrete sluice and onto Monks Way. Walk to the end of Monks Way and turn left onto Rockingham/Middlefield Road.

Cross over to the other side of Middlefield Road and turn down Crabapple Close. Turn left into the alley between numbers 1 and 3 and follow it until you emerge on The Briars. Turn right and walk along until you reach Middlefield Road again. Then turn right and walk past the schools to the end of the road.
